

General Information

INSTITUTIONAL HISTORY

Pakistan Adventist Seminary and College developed from a small Seventh-day Adventist **Pakistan Union Boys' School** located about 60 kilometers west of Lahore on the Lahore Sargodha Road at Farooqabad Mandi in 1920 under the leadership of O. O. Matison (Principal) (1920). In 1937 it became a co-educational institution with the integration of the Seventh-day Adventist girls' school from Chichoki Mallian.

Pakistan Adventist Seminary & College has been a boarding school since its beginning. It has separate dormitories for boys and girls which houses the students. The PASC cafeteria provides more than a three hundred students with vegetarian meals each day throughout the school year.

Steady growth followed as students came from all parts of the Punjab and Northwest India. However, as the school grew, students from all over the Pakistan and India came for study. After the partition of India and Pakistan in 1947, a new period began necessitating the development of a program on the tertiary level. In 1957 Pakistan Adventist Seminary & College was authorized by the Southern Asia Division of Seventh-day Adventists to begin a two-year junior (Intermediate) college program. After several years, authorization came to develop a senior college program Southern Asia Division. It held its first graduation exercises in 1970.

In 1985 Pakistan Adventist Seminary and College has been a part of the territory of the Trans-European Division of Seventh-day Adventists till 2012.

Effective from January 2012 Pakistan Union of Seventh-day Adventist Church has become a part of the South Asia Pacific Division (SSD) whose main office is in Silang Cavite, Philippines. In 2012 PASC also become the part of SSD.

The PASC now incorporates the Elementary School (Grades 1-6), High School (Grades 7-10), and Higher Secondary School (years 11-12) and the Degree program (four year college 13 – 16) A branch of Pakistan Adventist Seminary and College known as Community Learning Center (CLC) is also established in 2000 for the surrounding Muslim Community. It is composed of classes (Play to 12).

On August 2015, PASC board of Management decided to start offering Bachelor of Science courses (years 13-16) in college which requiring 12th year certificate as entrance requirement. In 2019 University of Sargodha permits have been secured for the following courses: such as Bachelor of Science in Information Technology, Bachelor of Science in English, Bachelor of Science in Business Administration major in Accountancy in college. Above mention courses are affiliated with University of Sargodha.

The PASC is a member of the Association of Seventh-day Adventist Universities, Colleges and Secondary Schools. Graduates of Pakistan Adventist Seminary & College are eligible to take advanced study at Graduate Schools of the Association. It is accredited by the Adventist Accrediting Association of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists in Washington, D. C. US.

LOCATION

Pakistan Adventist Seminary and College is located about 60 kilometers west of Lahore on the Lahore Sargodha Road at Farooqabad Mandi. Transportation is easily available at Farooqabad for travelling back and forth.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF OPERATION

The institution is owned and operated by the Seventh-day Adventist denomination. It receives no government grants. The PASC is maintained primarily to train workers for the church as well to educate sound Christian citizens who are able to be a positive influence to the Pakistani society. The purpose and scope of the institution is to provide quality Adventist Education to the poor Christian and non-Christian children of Pakistan so that they may be equipped to serve their country and God.

Pakistan Adventist Seminary and College is the only Adventist Educational Institution in Pakistan where a student can receive education from Play Group to College.
